

Wisconsin Society for Respiratory Care (WSRC) 2020 Board of Directors (BOD) Nominations

The qualifications for office are as follows:

1. Nominee must be an active member of the AARC
2. Nominee must be nominated by an active member of the AARC
 - a. You *can* nominate yourself with the endorsement of an AARC member
3. Nominee and Endorser must sign the nomination form
4. Candidates may be on the ballot for only one office per election.

Responsibilities and Duties for each Office Open for 2020 Nomination:

Vice President:

The Vice President will serve a two-year term. Responsibilities include; regular attendance at Board of Directors meetings, written budget proposals, foster communication with all respiratory care practitioners within the State of Wisconsin. This position is a member of Regulatory, Membership, Education Committees and ensures committee reports are submitted to the BOD. The Vice President will assume responsibility of the president's duties in the event of a vacancy of the president during the 2nd year of president's term. In addition, the Vice President performs all duties and responsibilities of the Society as a voting member of the Board of Directors and will assist the NRRCC Chair with duties as assigned.

Treasurer:

The Treasurer will serve a two-year term. The Treasurer shall account for the moneys of the Society; approve payment of bills and disburse funds under the direction of the Board of Directors in accordance with the approved budget; and be responsible for the continuing record of all income and disbursements. The Treasurer shall be bonded (at the expense of the Society). The Treasurer is a standing member of Budget and Audit Committee. Other responsibilities include; regular attendance at Board of Directors meetings, submission of financial reports and updates for scheduled BOD meetings and upon request of the BOD, process payments of accounts receivable on at least a 30 day basis, process reimbursement requests within a reasonable period of time to members of the WSRC upon receipt of proof of expenditure, ensure audit of all WSRC funds & accounts at the BOD request; or minimally every 3 years, maintain all checks and credit cards for WSRC, develop and provide an annual report of the finances of the Society for the preceding year, at the Annual Business Meeting.

District Representative: (2 Year Term): Responsibilities include attending all BOD meetings, hold at least one district meeting and one educational event per quarter (these may be combined into the same event), submit written reports of District meetings and activities for each scheduled BOD meetings, submit written budget proposals upon BOD of Directors request, submit hours of participation to President prior to any (WSRC/NRRCC) event for consideration of waived NRRCC registration. District Reps are standing members of the Membership Committee and are responsible for appointing student and therapist representative to assist with district events and activities, performs all duties and responsibilities of the Society as a voting member of the BOD.

*District Representative positions open for election in 2020:

District #1 Rep – NorthWest

District #3 Rep – NorthEast

District #5 Rep – SouthCentral

*Eligibility for District Representative shall be limited to active AARC members of the District in which they live or work. (Please refer to <http://www.wsrc.online/districts.html> for a district map)


