### New Casual - Limited Term Employee (LTE) temporary:

- **Special higher pay-rate** above our standard pay range and PRN rate. *Estimated duration dependent upon staffing needs, at least 3 months and up to 6 months but less than 1 year.*
- *This special temporary - limited term employee role is for external candidates and will allow an experienced RCP to be oriented via an expedited on-boarding process of a few shifts. versus typical multiple weeks for regular hires, assuming Skills Assessment and Competency Checklist and protocol reviews and precepted shifts are completed at acceptable standards.*
- Two options for Limited Term Employee roles:
  - 1) **Emergency Department** - requires a 12 hour **PM** shift (1030-2300 - 11:00pm) to staff EDTC -Level I Trauma Center. Must be able to work a minimum of 1-2 shifts per week to support staffing. Must have at least 2 years respiratory ED or critical care experienceOr
  - 2) **NICU (Level IV)** - requires a 12 hour **night** shift (6:30pm-7:00am), Requires minimum of 1-2 shifts per week for staffing in a Level IV NICU. Must have a minimum of 2 years Level III NICU experience.
